VI. Major scientific and innovation achievements

Short description of main scientific results and its confirmation (by awards, citations, development of international projects etc.)	<p>1. The list of the monuments of Russian history and culture in the Republic of Moldova has been updated. For this purpose there were used different sources of information - encyclopaedias, monographs, popular and scientific publications, archive materials, etc. Field research expeditions were carried out to gather additional information on the fate and condition of monuments (the nature of the restoration work, guardianship of monuments, the contents of museum exhibits, etc.). The results of investigations were published in a special scientific-information edition "Monuments of Russian history and culture in the Republic of Moldova".</p> <p>2. Certain historical documents related to the history of the Northern War of 1700-1721, Prut campaign of Peter I, and Moldovan emigration in Russia have been investigated in the archives. This work led to the creation of a collection of historical documents, which was included in the information package for the conference "Relay of valour and glory 'Victory banners flap so ...' " dedicated to the 300th anniversary of the Battle of Poltava.</p>
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	<p>The collection of historical documents consists of two sections. Section I «The Northern War: from the beginning to the Battle of Poltava" presents documents that describe the Petrine Russia in 1700 -1709 years: orders of Peter I, entries in the lists of noble families on measures for the defense of the territory of Ukraine; the plans of Charles XII; the composition and movements of Swedish and Turkish troops; the state and behaviour of the Cossack regiments; preparations for the decisive battle; letters of Peter I and A.D. Menshikov about the victory of Russian troops in the Battle of Poltava and the surrender of the Swedes at Perevolochnaya; the resignation of Charles XII and I.Mazepa on Turkish territory. Section II «Prut campaign of Peter I and Moldovan emigration in Russia" covers the period from 1711 to 1718. It presents documents of the Prut campaign; letters of D.Kantemir to Peter I about the status and position of the Moldovan ruler and Moldovan emigration in Russia.</p> <p>3. A series of historical documents of external and domestic policy, reflecting the policy of Russia in the 1st half of the XIX century in South-Eastern Europe and in Bessarabia have been selected and analysed. The documents were related to the Russian-Turkish war of 1806-1812, the Bucharest Peace Treaty of 1812, the annexation of Bessarabia to Russia and the development of the Bessarabian region in the I half of the XIX century as a part of Russia, the events and results of the Patriotic War of 1812 in Russia, etc.</p> <p>At the end there was published a collection of documents "1812 in the History of Russia and Moldova", 70 of which have been made public for the first time. The collection increased the number of primary sources for researchers of the history of Moldova and Russia of the 19th century.</p>
